



Contestant Rules and Agreements

Competition: benefiting AIDS Walk 2009

- Total up to 10 clubs between Phoenix and Tucson
- Each club will hold their own initial competitions beginning the week of August 1st
- One Competition per week 4 consecutive weeks 1 winner per night total of 4 winners for a 4 week period. (Each club sets its own quota for amount of contestants allowed in each of their competitions; you must sign up early so call ahead for details). Once a contestant has been chosen as a winner they are excluded to compete at another sponsoring club.
- Each contestant must agree to support their club each week after placement as a weekly winner.
- A 5th week competition will be established for each club hold a competition with all the preliminary winners to find they're sponsored talent. The winner will Then proceed to the final Competition held at Rainbows Festival

1st place Prize

- Presently is at \$1,000
- Featured Vocal performance on and Original Song Production and recording in conjunction with Wet Dog Promotions Entertainment and Majik Boys Music Productions. For International Release. (All rights retained by Wet Dog Promotions Entertainment and Majik Boys Music Productions).
- Winner will perform at the AIDS Walk 2009 on October 4th, at least 1 fund raising event for Aunt Rita's Foundation and Perform under your establishments sponsoring name @ Phoenix Pride 30 year anniversary 2010..

Judging

- Each club will judge their own initial competition 2 members of the bar and 1 non associated customer. Audience participation will hold ¼ of the balance of the vote in the Club vote.
- Rainbows Festival final - Presenting sponsor Hensley Budweiser and no less than 2 performers (Local or national)
- Wet Dog Promotions Rep or a sponsor representative will sit on the final competition board for each club..

Judging Criteria

▶ Categories: Appearance, Song choice, Vocal Ability, Audience participation and Overall performance.

▶ scoring

1= poor ----- poor

2= moderate ---- needs to do better

3= fair ----- middle of the road

4= good ----- good

5= excellent ----- excellent

Scoring will be exact for all parts of the competition and judging.....

Eligibility

▶ Contestants must be 21 years of age and provide legal proof upon request to compete in any bar. Competitors cannot be a member of any artistic union, cannot have made over \$1000 in the past 12 months performing their music and cannot currently have a recording contract with a record label. May not have held the of Arizona Gay Idol title the previous year.

▶ Must agree to the competition rules and process prior to entry of said competition. (No one is allowed to compete at anytime during this competition without a signature of these rules and agreement).

▶ Non-Discrimination Policy = Arizona Gay idol shall not discriminate person’s race, color, creed, religion, national origin, ancestry, age, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, domestic partner status, marital status, or disability. (If under 18 you must have a parent or legal guardian present at all times. Parent or Guardian must read and sign a permission voucher and support his or her child to be able to compete. (Competitions for under the age of 21 will only be held at authorized venues that do not have liquor sales, there will be no inclusion of under 21 participants in any bar).

Keep in mind the winner must uphold the title of Arizona Gay Idol and continue to represent oneself in such a manner that continues to appeal and positively represent the integrity of the Gay and Lesbian community as Wet Dog Promotions see fit.

▶ All contestants agree to allow Wet Dog Promotions to utilize contestant names, photos, vocal recordings or video for the promotional purposes of Arizona Gay Idol or Wet Dog Promotions.

▶ Arizona Gay Idol title holder for 2009 agrees to perform for AIDS Walk 2009 Sunday October 4th 2009, Phoenix Pride 2010 and any other agreed promotional events during the 2009-2010 raining year. Also agree to free performances for charitable events (transportation, lodging and musician expense is negotiable with event organization outside of festivals previously mentioned).

▶ All contestants must abide by the rules set forth by participating club Karaoke.

Responsibilities:

▶ Each contestant must acknowledge their own responsibility when choosing music. Some karaoke shows may not have your selection or may not have the ability to accommodate personal or copied media. Be prepared get to your club early; find out they're karaoke rules. There will be no duplicate song performances 1st come 1st served. Have your backup song choices ready to go.

▶ 1/4 of your score depends on the audience so give it all you got!

- Rainbows Festival finals –There will be a limited number of slow paced songs authorized for final performances. You must know your music and you must have a variety of polished songs ready to go.
- You will have to provide your own copy of your music choice for the finals. All competition songs must be submitted to Wet Dog Promotions no less than 3 days prior to event for approval.
- Wet Dog Promotions has final say on each song chosen for performance. Get them in early and have a variety submitted.
- No backup singers allowed
- Each contestant has the right to spice up they're stage show with a simple prop or back up dancer (no more than 2 allowed) all must be pre approved by Wet Dog Promotions Prior to Event.
- Your signature on the signup sheet states that you agree to all the terms of this competition and agree if chosen to complete the entire process of this competition to completion.
